Grievance committees have the authority to dismiss complaints or alter the application of these guidelines when they deem appropriate. The USTA League Tennis Committee asks all players, captains, coordinators, tennis professionals and volunteers to join the campaign to maintain the integrity of the NTRP Rating System!
